



**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1995 SENATE BILL 89**

March 9, 1995 – Offered by Senators BURKE, ANDREA and MOORE.

1 **AN ACT** *to repeal* 144.3716; and *to amend* 168.04 of the statutes; **relating to:**
2 the sale of reformulated gasoline.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 144.3716 of the statutes is repealed.

4 **SECTION 2.** 168.04 of the statutes is amended to read:

5 **168.04 Standards.** The department by rule shall prescribe minimum product
6 grade specifications for gasoline, ~~reformulated gasoline, as defined in s. 144.3716 (1),~~
7 and kerosene and may prescribe product grade specifications for automotive
8 gasoline, gasoline-alcohol fuel blends, aviation gasoline, fuel oils and diesel fuels.
9 Automotive gasoline specifications shall include lead content. The rules shall, to the
10 extent feasible, be in conformity with nationally recognized standards, specifications
11 and classifications, such as those published by the American society for testing and
12 materials, the society of automotive engineers and the U.S. environmental

1 protection agency. The department may not promulgate or enforce a rule prohibiting
2 additional information from placement on the dispensing device.
