ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 12, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 100

September 16, 1997 – Offered by Representative BAUMGART.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 1911, line 22: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 5318d. 943.13 (1e) (ej) of the statutes is created to read:
4	943.13 (1e) (ej) "Public access requirement" means any requirement under a
5	federal, state or local law that private land to which the law applies must be open
6	to public access, including access for specified purposes only.
7	SECTION 5318e. 943.13 (1m) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	943.13 (1m) (a) Enters any enclosed, cultivated or undeveloped land of another,
9	other than undeveloped land specified in par. (e) or, (f) <u>or (g)</u> , without the express or
10	implied consent of the owner or occupant.
11	SECTION 5318f. 943.13 (1m) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

1	042.12 (1mm) (f) Enters undeveloped private land from an abutting neural of
1	943.13 (1m) (f) Enters undeveloped private land from an abutting parcel of
2	land that is owned <u>or leased</u> by the United States, this state or a local governmental

4	not to enter or remain on the land.
5	SECTION 5318g. 943.13 (1m) (g) of the statutes is created to read:
6	943.13 (1m) (g) Enters undeveloped private land from an abutting parcel of
7	private land that is open to the public under a public access requirement, or remains
8	on such land, after having been notified by the owner or occupant not to enter or
9	remain on the land.
10	SECTION 5318h. 943.13 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
11	943.13 (2) (intro.) A person has received notice from the owner or occupant
12	within the meaning of sub. (1m) (b), (e) or, (f) $\underline{\text{or}}(\underline{g})$ if he or she has been notified
13	personally, either orally or in writing, or if the land is posted. Land is considered to
14	be posted under this subsection under either of the following procedures:".
15	2. Page 2059, line 23: after that line insert:
16	"(2s) Changes in trespass law. The treatment of section 943.13 (1e) (ej), (1m)
17	(a), (f) and (g) and (2) (intro.) of the statutes first applies to offenses committed on the
18	effective date of this subsection.".
