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**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 188**

March 13, 1997 - Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

- 1           At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
- 2           **1.** Page 7, line 16: delete "*loan program*" and substitute "*programs*".
- 3           **2.** Page 7, line 18: after "281.61" insert: "and for other drinking water quality  
4 activities under s. 281.62".
- 5           **3.** Page 7, line 19: delete "*loan program*" and substitute "*programs*".
- 6           **4.** Page 7, line 24: after "281.61" insert: "and for other drinking water quality  
7 activities under s. 281.62".
- 8           **5.** Page 8, line 4: substitute ", 281.61 or 281.62" for "or 281.61".
- 9           **6.** Page 8, line 16: after "281.61" insert: "and other drinking water quality  
10 activities under s. 281.62".
- 11          **7.** Page 8, line 21: substitute ", 281.61 and 281.62" for "and 281.61".
- 12          **8.** Page 9, line 5: delete "*loan program*" and substitute "*programs*".

1           **9.** Page 9, line 8: delete “the safe drinking water loan program” and substitute:  
2 “safe drinking water programs”.

3           **10.** Page 9, line 10: after “281.61” insert: “and other drinking water quality  
4 activities under s. 281.62”.

5           **11.** Page 10, line 13: substitute “, 281.61 and 281.62” for “and 281.61”.

6           **12.** Page 13, line 7: delete “and all” and substitute: “and, except as provided  
7 under sub. (2m) (b), all”.

8           **13.** Page 13, line 8: after “(b)” insert: “and all moneys transferred to the  
9 account under sub. (2m) (a)”.

10           **14.** Page 13, line 12: delete “and all” and substitute: “, except as provided  
11 under sub. (2m) (a), all”.

12           **15.** Page 13, line 13: after “(bm)” insert: “and all moneys transferred to the  
13 account under sub. (2m) (b)”.

14           **16.** Page 13, line 24: after that line insert:

15           “**SECTION 41m.** 25.43 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

16           25.43 **(2m)** (a) In any year, the governor may transfer an amount that does not  
17 exceed 33% of a capitalization grant under sub. (1) (am) provided in that year from  
18 the account under sub. (2) (am) to the account under sub. (2) (a).

19           (b) In any year, the governor may transfer an amount that does not exceed 33%  
20 of a capitalization grant under sub. (1) (am) provided in that year from the account  
21 under sub. (2) (a) to the account under sub. (2) (am).”.

22           **17.** Page 14, line 5: substitute “, 281.61 and 281.62” for “and 281.61”.

23           **18.** Page 37, line 11: after that line insert:

1           **“SECTION 106m.** 281.62 of the statutes is created to read:

2           **281.62 Other drinking water quality activities. (1)** In this section:

3           (a) “Community water system” means a public water system that serves at  
4           least 15 service connections used by year-round residents of the area served by the  
5           public water system or that regularly serves at least 25 year-round residents.

6           (b) “Noncommunity water system” means a public water system that is not a  
7           community water system.

8           (c) “Public water system” has the meaning given in s. 281.61 (1) (c).

9           **(2)** (a) With the approval of the department of administration, the department  
10           may expend funds from the appropriation accounts under s. 20.320 (2) (s) and (x) for  
11           any of the following:

12           1. Providing a loan to the owner of a community water system or a nonprofit  
13           noncommunity water system to acquire land or a conservation easement from a  
14           willing seller or grantor to protect the source water of the water system from  
15           contamination and to ensure compliance with national primary drinking water  
16           regulations under 42 USC 300g-1.

17           2. Providing a loan to the owner of a community water system to do any of the  
18           following:

19           a. Implement voluntary source water protection measures in areas delineated  
20           as provided in 42 USC 300j-13 in order to facilitate compliance with national  
21           primary drinking water regulations under 42 USC 300g-1 or otherwise significantly  
22           further the health protection objectives of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 USC 300f  
23           to 300j-26.

24           b. Implement a program for source water quality protection partnerships as  
25           provided in 42 USC 300j-14.

1           3. Assisting the owner of a public water system to develop the technical,  
2 managerial and financial capacity to comply with national primary drinking water  
3 regulations under 42 USC 300g-1.

4           4. Delineating or assessing source water protection areas as provided under 42  
5 USC 300j-13.

6           5. Protecting wellhead areas from contamination as provided in 42 USC  
7 300h-7.

8           (b) In any fiscal year, the department may not expend under par. (a) more than  
9 15% of the funds provided under 42 USC 300j-12 in that fiscal year. In any fiscal  
10 year, the department may not expend under par. (a) 1., 2., 3., 4. or 5. more than 10%  
11 of the funds provided under 42 USC 300j-12 in that fiscal year.

12           **(3)** (a) With the approval of the department of administration, the department  
13 may expend funds from the appropriation accounts under s. 20.320 (2) (s) and (x) for  
14 any of the following:

15           1. Public water system supervision as provided in 42 USC 300j-2 (a).

16           2. Technical assistance concerning source water protection.

17           3. Developing and implementing a capacity development strategy required  
18 under 42 USC 300g-9 (c).

19           4. Operator certification required under 42 USC 300g-8.

20           (b) In any fiscal year, the department may not expend under par. (a) more than  
21 10% of the funds provided under 42 USC 300j-12 in that fiscal year.

22           **(4)** With the approval of the department of administration, the department  
23 may expend funds from the appropriation accounts under s. 20.320 (2) (s) and (x) to  
24 provide technical assistance to public water systems serving 10,000 or fewer persons.

1 In any fiscal year, the department may not expend under this subsection more than  
2 2% of the funds provided under 42 USC 300j-12 in that fiscal year.”
