## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 221

May 8, 1997 – Offered by Committee on Criminal Justice and Corrections.

1	AN ACT to create 940.20 (8) and 940.20 (9) of the statutes; relating to: causing
2	bodily harm to a viable fetus or a pregnant woman and providing penalties.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	<b>SECTION 1.</b> 940.20 (8) of the statutes is created to read:
4	940.20 (8) BATTERY TO VIABLE FETUS. (a) In this subsection, "viability" has the
5	meaning given in s. 940.15 (1).
6	(b) Whoever intentionally causes bodily harm to a fetus that has reached
7	viability by an act done without the consent of the pregnant woman is guilty of a
8	Class C felony.
9	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 940.20 (9) of the statutes is created to read:
10	940.20 (9) BATTERY TO PREGNANT WOMAN. Whoever intentionally causes bodily
11	harm to a pregnant woman by an act done without the consent of the woman and

1 knowing or having reason to know that the woman is pregnant is guilty of a Class

2 D felony.

## 3 SECTION 3. Initial applicability.

4 (1) This act applies to offenses occurring on or after the effective date of this5 subsection.
