



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 308**

May 7, 1998 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION, AGRICULTURE AND RURAL AFFAIRS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by assembly substitute
2 amendment 3, as follows:

3 **1.** Page 3, line 10: after that line insert:

4 “(c) Any zoning ordinance that is enacted, or resolution that is adopted, under
5 s. 59.69, 60.61, 60.62, 61,35 or 62.23 (7) that is related to noise.

6 **(6)** A city, village town or county may regulate the hours between 11:00 p.m.
7 and 6:00 a.m. that an outdoor sport shooting range may operate, except that such a
8 regulation may not apply to a law enforcement officer as defined in s. 165.85 (2) (c),
9 a member of the U.S. armed forces or a private security person as defined in s. 440.26
10 (1m) (h) who meets all of the requirements under s. 167.31 (4) (a) 4.

11 **(7)** A person who is shooting in the customary or a generally acceptable manner
12 at a sport shooting range between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 11:00 p.m. is presumed

1 to not be engaging in disorderly conduct merely because of the noise caused by the
2 shooting.”.
