



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 462**

December 2, 1997 - Offered by Representative STASKUNAS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 20: delete lines 20 and 21 and substitute:

3 **“(2)** In this section:

4 (a) “Governmental headquarters” means a city hall or other building where a
5 common council generally meets; a village hall or other building where a village
6 board generally meets; a town hall or other building where a town board generally
7 meets; a county seat or the principal administration building of a school district.

8 (b) “Local governmental unit” means any city, village, town, county or school
9 district.”.

10 **2.** Page 5, line 22: after “(4)” insert “and subject to par. (c)”.

11 **3.** Page 6, line 2: after “works” insert “if he or she and his or her spouse live
12 within 15 miles of the governmental headquarters of the local governmental unit for
13 which he or she works”.

1 **4.** Page 6, line 10: after “63.25 (1) (a)” insert “ if he or she and his or her spouse
2 live within 15 miles of the governmental headquarters of the local governmental unit
3 for which he or she would like to apply for a job or for which he or she would like to
4 take a test”.

5 **5.** Page 6, line 10: after that line insert:

6 “(c) 1. If a married couple that is described in par. (a) resides within the
7 jurisdictional limits of one of the local governmental units that has a residency
8 requirement and that employs one of the spouses and that couple ceases to live
9 together because of legal separation, divorce, death of one of the spouses or any other
10 reason, the spouse, or former spouse, that is not living within the jurisdictional limits
11 of the local governmental unit with which he or she is employed is subject to the
12 residency requirement of that local governmental unit on the first day of the 6th
13 month beginning after the couple ceases to live together.

14 2. If a married couple that is described in par. (a) resides within the
15 jurisdictional limits of one of the local governmental units that has a residency
16 requirement and that employs one of the spouses and the residency requirement of
17 that local governmental unit ceases to apply, the spouse that is not living in the local
18 governmental unit for which he or she works is subject to the residency requirement
19 of that local governmental unit on the first day of the 6th month beginning after the
20 residency requirement of the local governmental unit in which the couple resides
21 ceases to apply.”.
