**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 496**

December 4, 1997 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 16: after that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 4g.** 343.30 (1q) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

4 343.30 **(1q)** (b) 3. Except as provided in subd. 4m., if the number of convictions,
5 suspensions and revocations ~~within a 5-year period~~ equals 2, the court shall revoke
6 the person's operating privilege for not less than one year nor more than 18 months.
7 After the first 60 days of the revocation period, the person is eligible for an
8 occupational license under s. 343.10 if he or she has completed the assessment and
9 is complying with the driver safety plan ordered under par. (c).

10 **SECTION 4j.** 343.30 (1q) (b) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:

11 343.30 **(1q)** (b) 4. Except as provided in subd. 4m., if the number of convictions,
12 suspensions and revocations ~~within a 10-year period~~ equals 3 or more, the court
13 shall revoke the person's operating privilege for not less than 2 years nor more than

1 3 years. After the first 90 days of the revocation period, the person is eligible for an
2 occupational license under s. 343.10 if he or she has completed the assessment and
3 is complying with the driver safety plan ordered under par. (c).

4 **SECTION 4m.** 343.30 (1q) (b) 5. of the statutes is repealed.”.
