## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 496

December 4, 1997 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON HIGHWAYS AND TRANSPORTATION.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	<b>1.</b> Page 4, line 16: after that line insert:
3	<b>"SECTION 4g.</b> 343.30 (1q) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:
4	343.30 (1q) (b) 3. Except as provided in subd. 4m., if the number of convictions,
5	suspensions and revocations <del>within a 5-year period</del> equals 2, the court shall revoke
6	the person's operating privilege for not less than one year nor more than 18 months.
7	After the first 60 days of the revocation period, the person is eligible for an
8	occupational license under s. 343.10 if he or she has completed the assessment and
9	is complying with the driver safety plan ordered under par. (c).
10	<b>SECTION 4j.</b> 343.30 (1q) (b) 4. of the statutes is amended to read:
11	343.30 (1q) (b) 4. Except as provided in subd. 4m., if the number of convictions,
12	suspensions and revocations within a 10-year period equals 3 or more, the court
13	shall revoke the person's operating privilege for not less than 2 years nor more than
