**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1997 ASSEMBLY BILL 50**

October 21, 1997 - Offered by COMMITTEE ON TOURISM AND RECREATION.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 23.33 (5) (a) of the statutes; **relating to:** relating to the
2 operation of all-terrain vehicles by minors.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 23.33 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 23.33 (5) (a) *Age restriction.* No person under 12 years of age may operate an
5 all-terrain vehicle unless he or she is operating the all-terrain vehicle for an
6 agricultural purpose and he or she is under the supervision of a person over 18 years
7 of age or unless he or she is operating a small all-terrain vehicle on an all-terrain
8 vehicle trail designated by the department, on an all-terrain vehicle route, on public
9 property on which the operation of all-terrain vehicles is permitted or on private
10 property on which the property owner has given permission to operate all-terrain
11 vehicles and he or she is accompanied by his or her parent or guardian or by a person
12 who is at least 21 years of age. No person who is under 12 years of age may operate

1 an all-terrain vehicle ~~which is an implement of husbandry~~ that is not a small
2 all-terrain vehicle on a roadway or on a shoulder of a roadway under any
3 circumstances. No person who is under 12 years of age may operate ~~an~~ a small
4 all-terrain vehicle on a roadway ~~under the authorization provided under sub. (4) (d)~~
5 ~~6. under any circumstances or on a shoulder of a roadway except to cross the roadway~~
6 in the manner required under sub. (4) (d) 1. if the crossing is part of an all-terrain
7 vehicle trail or all-terrain vehicle route and the person is accompanied by his or her
8 parent or guardian or by a person who is at least 21 years of age. No person who is
9 under 12 years of age may rent or lease an all-terrain vehicle. For purposes of this
10 paragraph, supervision does not require that the person under 12 years of age be
11 subject to continuous direction or control by the person over 18 years of age.
