- 4 "Section 311r. 74.48 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

74.48 (1) If land that has been valued under s. 70.32 (2r) (b) is sold by a person who has owned it for less than 5 years and who has benefited from a value lower than that established by s. 70.32 (2r) (a) the assessment as of January 1, 1995, there is imposed on that person a penalty equal to 5% of the difference between the sale price of the agricultural land and the value that would be established for it under s. 70.32 (2r) (c) during the last year of the person's ownership.".
