9	(a) "Captive" means any of the following:

2. Restrained by physical alterations that limit movement or facilitate capture.

1. Restrained by a cage, pen, fence or other enclosure.

3. Restrained by a leash or a tether or otherwise tied.

- 4. Held in a controlled environment that is designed to prevent the departure from the controlled environment.
- (b) "Domesticated mammal" means farm-raised deer or a mammal that is all of the following:
- 1. A mammal that, due to a long association with humans, has been bred to a degree that results in changes affecting the mammal's temperament, color, conformation or other attribute of the species to an extent that it makes the animal unique and distinguishable from a wild mammal of its species.
  - 2. Listed as a domesticated mammal by rule by the department.
- (c) "Wild mammal" means any mammal of a wild nature that is normally found in the wild and that is not a domesticated mammal.
- (2) Prohibition; commercial hunting. No person may sell or offer to sell or purchase or offer to purchase the opportunity to hunt any wild mammal that is captive except as authorized by rule by the department.".
