**SENATE AMENDMENT 3,  
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1997 SENATE BILL 315**

January 15, 1998 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON HEALTH, HUMAN SERVICES, AGING,  
CORRECTIONS, VETERANS AND MILITARY AFFAIRS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 22: delete “The” and substitute “The Unless sub. (13) applies,  
3 the”.

4 **2.** Page 6, line 13: delete “, ~~the~~ The” and substitute “Unless sub. (13) applies,  
5 the”.

6 **3.** Page 7, line 6: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 21m.** 153.05 (13) of the statutes is created to read:

8 153.05 (13) The department may waive the requirement under sub. (1), (5) or  
9 (8) for a physician, as defined in s. 448.01 (5), who requests the waiver and presents  
10 evidence to the department that the requirement under sub. (1), (5) or (8) is  
11 burdensome, under standards established by the department by rule. The

1 department shall develop a form for use by a physician in submitting a request under  
2 this subsection.”.

3 **4.** Page 14, line 5: delete “and (s)” and substitute “, (s) and (t)”.

4 **5.** Page 14, line 20: after that line insert:

5 “(t) Establishing standards for determining under s. 153.05 (13) if a  
6 requirement under s. 153.05 (1), (5) or (8) is burdensome for a physician.”.
