  - **7.** Page 15, line 15: after that line insert:

"Section 56g. 227.01 (13) (yt) of the statutes is created to read:

227.01 (13) (yt) Relates to the amounts of assessments that are made under s. 153.60 (1) for health care providers other than hospitals and ambulatory surgery centers.

**Section 56r.** 440.03 (11m) of the statutes is created to read:

440.03 **(11m)** The department shall work together with the department of health and family services to develop a mechanism for collecting assessments under s. 153.60 (1) from health care providers other than hospitals and ambulatory surgery centers.".
