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SENATE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1997 SENATE BILL 325

February 12, 1998 – Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 1, line 3: delete "programs and" and substitute "programs,".
3	${f 2.}$ Page 1, line 5: after "program" insert "and making an appropriation".
4	3. Page 2, line 1: before that line insert:
5	"SECTION 1g. 20.445 (3) (dz) of the statutes, as affected by 1997 Wisconsin Act
6	27, section 627, is amended to read:
7	20.445 (3) (dz) Wisconsin works and other public assistance administration and
8	benefits. The amounts in the schedule for administration and benefit payments

Payments may be made from this appropriation to counties 8 for fraud investigation and error reduction under s. 49.197 (1m) and (4). Moneys 9 appropriated under this paragraph may be used to match federal funds received 10 under par. (md). Notwithstanding ss. 20.001 (3) (a) and 20.002 (1), the department 11 may transfer funds between fiscal years under this paragraph. All funds allocated by the department but not encumbered by December 31 of each year lapse to the 1213general fund on the next January 1 unless transferred to the next calendar year by 14the joint committee on finance.

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SECTION 1h. 20.445 (3) (dz) of the statutes, as affected by 1997 Wisconsin Act 27, section 627b, and 1997 Wisconsin Act (this act), is repealed and recreated to read:

Payments may be made from this appropriation to counties for fraud investigation 9 and error reduction under s. 49.197 (1m) and (4). Moneys appropriated under this 10 paragraph may be used to match federal funds received under par. (md). 11 Notwithstanding ss. 20.001 (3) (a) and 20.002 (1), the department may transfer funds 12between fiscal years under this paragraph. All funds allocated by the department 13but not encumbered by December 31 of each year lapse to the general fund on the 14next January 1 unless transferred to the next calendar year by the joint committee 15on finance.

SECTION 1m. 49.175 (1) (h) of the statutes, as created by 1997 Wisconsin Act
27, is amended to read:

49.175 (1) (h) (title) Funeral, burial and cemetery expenses. For funeral, burial
 and cemetery expenses under s. 49.30, \$3,300,000 in each fiscal year \$3,846,900 in
 fiscal year 1997–98 and \$5,487,500 in fiscal year 1998–99.".

- 21 **4.** Page 2, line 1: delete "SECTION 1" and substitute "SECTION 1r".
- 22 **5.** Page 2, line 8: after that line insert:
- 23 "SECTION 2m. Appropriation changes.

1 (1) FUNERAL AND BURIAL EXPENSES. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of 2 the statutes for the appropriation to the department of workforce development under 3 section 20.445 (3) (dz) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1997, the dollar 4 amount is increased by \$514,100 for fiscal year 1997–98 and the dollar amount is 5 increased by \$2,056,300 for fiscal year 1998–99 to increase funding for funeral and 6 burial expenses under section 49.30 of the statutes.".

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7 **6.** Page 2, line 13: after that line insert:

8 "SECTION 4m. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after 9 publication, except as follows:

10 (1) FUNERAL, BURIAL AND CEMETERY EXPENSES. The repeal and recreation of
11 section 20.445 (3) (dz) of the statutes takes effect on February 1, 1999.".
