## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 20, TO ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 133

8	peripheral equipment, tape drives, printers, basic operational programs, systems
9	software, prewritten software and custom software. The exemption under this
10	subsection does not apply to fax machines, copiers, equipment with embedded
11	computerized components or telephone systems, including equipment that is used

1	to provide telecommunications services, as defined in s. 76.80 (3). <u>This subsection</u>
