



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 141**

March 2, 2000 – Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: before “and providing a penalty” insert “, making an
3 appropriation”.

4 **2.** Page 3, line 2: after that line insert:

5 **“SECTION 6g. Nonstatutory provisions.**

6 (1) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) (e) of the statutes, in submitting
7 information under section 16.42 of the statutes for the purpose of the 2001–03
8 biennial budget bill, the department of transportation shall submit information
9 concerning the appropriation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes as though
10 the amounts appropriated to the department under that appropriation for fiscal year
11 2000–01 were \$37,500 less than the amounts in the schedule.

12 **SECTION 6m. Appropriation changes.**

1 (1) In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation
2 to the department of transportation under section 20.395 (5) (cq) of the statutes, as
3 affected by the acts of 1999, the dollar amount is increased by \$37,500 for fiscal year
4 2000–01 to reflecting vehicle color on motor vehicle registration.”.

5 **3.** Page 3, line 6: delete lines 6 to 8 and substitute:

6 “**SECTION 8m. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the first day of the 4th
7 month beginning after publication or on July 1, 2000, whichever is later, except as
8 follows:

9 (1) SECTION 6m of this act takes effect on the day after publication.”.
