1	SECTION 2. 20.435 (5) (cm) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:			
2	20.435 (5) (cm) (title) Immunization <u>of children</u> .			
3	SECTION 3. 20.435 (5) (cn) of the statutes is created to read:			
4	20.435 (5) (cn) Anthrax immunization. The amounts in the schedule for			
5	providing immunization against anthrax under s. 252.043.			
6	SECTION 4. 252.043 of the statutes is created to read:			
7	252.043 Anthrax immunization program. (1) In this section:			
8	(a) "Anthrax" means an infectious disease, caused by the ingestion of spores of			
9	Bacillus anthracis, that is transmittable to humans by direct inoculation from			
10	contaminated wool or other animal products, by ingestion of raw meat or by			
11	inhalation of airborne spores from animal products.			
12	(b) "Emergency medical technician" has the meaning given in s. 146.50 (1) (e).			
13	(c) "First responder" has the meaning given in s. 146.53 (1) (d).			
14	(d) "Law enforcement officer" has the meaning given in s. 165.85 (2) (c).			
15	(2) From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (5) (cn), the department shall			
16	distribute moneys for the immunization against anthrax of all of the following			
17	persons:			
18	(a) Emergency medical technicians.			
19	(b) First responders.			
20	(c) Law enforcement officers.			
21	(d) Employes of municipal and county emergency management units, as			
22	specified in s. 166.03 (8) (d).			
23	(e) Volunteer emergency management workers, as described under s. 166.03			
24	(8) (d).			

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1	(f) Persons who provide equipment or services during a state of emergency, as
2	described under s. 166.03 (10).
3	(g) Persons holding a state office, as defined in s. 5.02 (23).
4	(h) Members of town and village boards and of the common councils of cities.
5	(i) Members of county boards of supervisors.
6	(j) Other persons, as specified by rule by the department.
7	(3) Subsection (2) may not be construed to imply that immunization against
8	anthrax may be provided to persons without their informed consent.
9	(4) The department shall promulgate rules that prescribe procedures for the
10	distribution of moneys under sub. (2) and may promulgate rules that specify
11	additional persons who may receive immunization against anthrax.
