| 4 | written report indicating that a violation has occurred. If possible, the report shall |

| 6 | (a) The time and the approximate location at which the violation occurred. |
| 7 | (b) The license number and color of the motor vehicle involved in the violation. |
| 8 | (c) Identification of the motor vehicle as an automobile, station wagon, motor |
| 9 | truck, motor bus, motorcycle or other type of vehicle. |
| 10 | (d) A description of the accident, including a description of the person, vehicle |
| 11 | or property that was struck. |
| 12 | (3m) (a) Within 24 hours after observing the violation, a person may deliver |
| 13 | a report prepared under sub. (3) to a traffic officer of the county or municipality in |
