**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 674**

February 16, 2000 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON VETERANS AND MILITARY AFFAIRS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 4: after “institutions” insert “and contributions for a World War
3 II memorial in Washington, D.C.”.

4 **2.** Page 8, line 2: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 19m.** 45.054 of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act 2,
6 section 5, is amended to read:

7 **45.054 World War II memorial.** The department of veterans affairs may
8 accept contributions of money as gifts on behalf of Wisconsin veterans for the
9 construction of a World War II memorial to be located in Washington, D.C. The
10 moneys received under this section shall be deposited in the general fund and
11 credited to the appropriation account under s. 20.485 (2) (gd). The department may
12 not accept any contributions under this section after ~~April 30~~ May 10, 2000. From
13 the appropriation under s. 20.485 (2) (dm), the department shall match any moneys

1 received under this section, up to a maximum of \$166,100. The department shall pay
2 that match amount plus the moneys credited to the appropriation account under s.
3 20.485 (2) (gd) to the American Battle Monuments Commission by May ~~15~~ 20, 2000,
4 for the construction of a memorial on federal land in the District of Columbia to honor
5 members of the U.S. armed forces who served in World War II.”
