ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 9, TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 701

February 9, 2000 – Offered by Representative Schneider.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:
2	1. Page 25, line 2: after that line insert:
3	"SECTION 26m. 8.30 (5) of the statutes is created to read:
4	8.30 (5) The board shall not place the name of a candidate on the ballot at the
5	general election or a special partisan election if the candidate is subject to a filing
6	requirement under s. 11.20 (2w) and a report is not filed in a timely manner by the
7	candidate or his or her personal campaign committee as required under s. 11.20 $(2w)$.
8	If ballots are required to be prepared before the board is required to act under this
9	subsection, the board shall remove the candidate's name from the ballot if possible.".
10	2. Page 34, line 22: after that line insert:
11	"SECTION 50d. 11.20 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
12	11.20 (2) Preprimary and preelection reports under s. 11.06 (1) shall be
13	received by the appropriate filing officer no earlier than 14 days and no later than

(2w) is not <u>required to file a pree</u>lection report under this subsection. 3 4 **SECTION 50h.** 11.20 (2w) of the statutes is created to read: $\mathbf{5}$ 11.20 (2w) Election reports under s. 11.12 shall be received by the board no 6 later than the Monday following each September primary and each special partisan 7 primary and no later than each Monday thereafter, through the Monday following 8 the date of the general or special partisan election, from each candidate or personal 9 campaign committee of a candidate for state office, except the office of district 10 attorney, who received at least 6% of the vote cast for all candidates for the same office 11 at the September primary or the special partisan primary, if a primary was held, but 12who did not accept a grant under s. 11.50. The reports may be filed no earlier than 13the Monday on which they are due. **SECTION 50p.** 11.20 (8) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read: 141511.20 (8) (intro.) Reports filed under subs. (2), (2w), (4) and (4m) shall include 16 all contributions received and transactions made as of the end of: 17**SECTION 50t.** 11.20 (8) (f) of the statutes is created to read: 18 11.20 (8) (f) The Friday preceding the date that the report is due in the case of 19 the report required to be filed under sub.
