



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 11,  
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 79**

February 17, 1999 – Offered by Representatives HEBL, OLSEN, STASKUNAS and SHERMAN.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 11: delete lines 11 to 15 and substitute:

3 “**SECTION 7L.** 939.645 (2) (b) of the statutes is renumbered 939.645 (2) (b)  
4 (intro.) and amended to read:

5 939.645 (2) (b) (intro.) If the crime committed under sub. (1) or (1m) is  
6 ordinarily a Class A misdemeanor, the penalty ~~increase under this section changes~~  
7 ~~the status of the crime to a felony and the~~ is increased as follows:

8 1. For a Class A misdemeanor committed under sub. (1), the revised maximum  
9 fine is \$10,000 and the revised maximum period of imprisonment is 2 years. ~~The~~  
10 penalty increase under this subdivision changes the status of the crime from a  
11 misdemeanor to a felony.

12 **SECTION 7m.** 939.645 (2) (b) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

1           939.645 (2) (b) 2. For a Class A misdemeanor committed under sub. (1m), the  
2       revised maximum fine is \$10,000 and the revised maximum period of imprisonment  
3       is 2 years. The penalty increase under this subdivision does not change the status  
4       of the crime from a misdemeanor to a felony.”
