**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 802**

March 2, 2000 - Offered by JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE.

1 **AN ACT to amend** 46.80 (5) (a); and **to create** 20.435 (7) (kn) and 20.505 (8) (hm)
2 18dm. of the statutes; **relating to:** supplemental funding for elderly nutrition
3 programs and making appropriations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert
5 the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

1 **SECTION 2.** 20.435 (7) (kn) of the statutes is created to read:

2 20.435 (7) (kn) *Elderly nutrition; home-delivered and congregate meals.* The
3 amounts in the schedule for home-delivered and congregate meals under the state
4 supplement to the federal congregate nutrition projects under s. 46.80 (5) (a). All
5 moneys transferred from the appropriation account under s. 20.505 (8) (hm) 18dm.
6 shall be credited to this appropriation.

7 **SECTION 3.** 20.505 (8) (hm) 18dm. of the statutes is created to read:

8 20.505 (8) (hm) 18dm. The amount transferred to s. 20.435 (7) (kn) shall be the
9 amount in the schedule under s. 20.435 (7) (kn).

10 **SECTION 4.** 46.80 (5) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

11 46.80 (5) (a) From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (7) (dh), the department
12 shall provide a state supplement to the federal congregate nutrition projects under
13 42 USC 3030e, in effect on April 30, 1980, which will promote expansion of projects
14 throughout the state and, from the appropriation under s. 20.435 (7) (kn), the
15 department shall provide a state supplement to the federal congregate nutrition
16 projects of \$450,000 for home-delivered meals and \$50,000 for congregate meals.
17 Except as provided in par. (b), the department shall allocate these funds based on the
18 formulas developed by the department under sub. (2m) (a) 2. A county that receives
19 federal funds for congregate nutrition projects on or after July 1, 1977, may not
20 receive under this paragraph an amount that is less than the 1976–77 allocation as
21 a result of the program expansion. This paragraph does not require that federal
22 limitations on the use of federal congregate nutrition funds for home delivered meals
23 apply to the state supplement.
