**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 SENATE BILL 179**

June 23, 1999 – Offered by Representative NASS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 6: after that line, on page 2, line 1, of the material inserted by
3 senate amendment 1, after “(1)” insert “RECONCILIATION.”.

4 **2.** Page 4, line 6: after that line, on page 2 of the material inserted by senate
5 amendment 1, after line 3, insert:

6 “(2) REPORT ON PROPOSED TUNNEL PROJECT. The department of administration
7 shall submit a report to the joint committee on finance concerning any proposed
8 tunnel between the capitol building and any building facing Main Street in the city
9 of Madison that is wholly or partially owned or leased by the state. The report shall
10 include information about the proposed design and usage of the tunnel and the
11 personnel who would have access to the tunnel.

12 (3) FUNDING FOR TUNNEL CONSTRUCTION. Notwithstanding section 18.04 (2) of
13 the statutes, the building commission shall not authorize any public debt to be

1 contracted under section 20.866 (2) (y) of the statutes, as affected by this act, or any
2 other public debt to be contracted, for the purpose of constructing any tunnel
3 specified in subsection (2) until the cochair persons of the joint committee on finance
4 notify the secretary of the building commission that the report required under
5 subsection (2) has been submitted and approved by the committee.”.
