



**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 1999 SENATE BILL 44**

February 25, 1999 – Offered by COMMITTEE ON PRIVACY, ELECTRONIC COMMERCE AND FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 4: delete “If” and substitute “(a) Except as provided in par. (b),  
3 if”.

4 **2.** Page 1, line 9: after that line insert:

5 “(b) Unless specifically prohibited by federal or state law, a requester may have  
6 access to a record containing the social security account number of an individual if  
7 the requester is an authorized representative of an insurer or an organization that  
8 performs investigations for insurers and the social security account number is  
9 relevant to an investigation of suspected, anticipated or actual insurance fraud.”.
