ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 24, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO ASSEMBLY BILL 1

May 15, 2002 – Offered by Representative Gronemus.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 2, line 5: after that line insert:
3	"(fu) Chronic wasting disease —
4	hunter reimbursement SEG C \$750,000 -0-".
5	2. Page 2, line 18: delete "29.063" and substitute "29.063 (1)".
6	3. Page 2, line 18: after that line insert:
7	"SECTION 3m. 20.370 (5) (fu) of the statutes is created to read:
8	20.370 (5) (fu) Chronic wasting disease — hunter reimbursement. As a
9	continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule to reimburse hunters for deer
10	killed to control chronic wasting disease under s. 29.063 (2).".
11	4. Page 2, line 22: delete "29.063" and substitute "29.063 (1)".

1	5. Page 3, line 1: after " disease. " insert "(1)".
2	6. Page 3, line 3: after that line insert:
3	"(2) (a) If the department designates an area as a chronic wasting disease
4	eradication zone, the department, from the appropriation under s. 20.370 (5) (fu),
5	shall reimburse a person \$50 for each deer he or she kills in the zone for the purpose
6	of controlling the spread of the disease if all of the following apply:
7	1. The person is authorized by the department to engage in hunting for this
8	purpose.
9	2. The person delivers the carcass to the department.
10	(b) If sufficient funds are not available from the appropriation under s. 20.370
11	(5) (fu) to reimburse each person as required under this subsection, the department
12	shall prorate the reimbursement payments in a manner determined by the
13	department.".
