ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 165

May 15, 2001 – Offered by Representative Olsen.

1 AN ACT to repeal and recreate 118.045 (3) of the statutes; relating to: the 2 commencement of the school term in public schools.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **SECTION 1.** 118.045 (3) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read: 4 118.045 (3) A school board may commence the school term before September 1 in an odd-numbered year and in the succeeding even-numbered year if all of the 5 6 following apply: 7 (a) At the annual meeting held in a common or union high school district in the 8 previous even-numbered year, a public hearing is held on the issue. 9 (b) If the school district is not a common or union high school district, the school 10 board holds a public hearing on the issue after May 14 and before October 1 in the 11 previous even-numbered year.

1 (c) Following the public hearing under par. (a) or (b), but before the employment 2 relations commission receives a notice of the commencement of contract negotiations 3 under s. 111.70 (4) (cm) 1. for the collective bargaining agreement whose term begins 4 in the succeeding odd-numbered year, the school board adopts a resolution to that 5 effect.

SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

7 (1) This act first applies to the commencement of the school term in the 2003-04
8 school year.
