**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 374**

July 19, 2001 - Offered by Representative STONE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 3, line 9: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
3 page 5, line 4, and substitute:

4 “**SECTION 9m.** 347.25 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

5 347.25 (1) Except as provided in subs. (1m) (a), (1r), and (1s), an authorized
6 emergency vehicle may be equipped with one or more flashing, oscillating, or
7 rotating red lights, except that ambulances, fire department equipment, and
8 privately owned motor vehicles under s. 340.01 (3) (d), ~~(dg)~~, or (dm) being used by
9 personnel of a full-time or part-time fire department ~~or~~, by members of a volunteer
10 fire department or rescue squad, or by an organ procurement organization or any
11 person under an agreement with an organ procurement organization, may be
12 equipped with red or red and white lights, and shall be so equipped when the operator
13 thereof is exercising the privileges granted by s. 346.03. The lights shall be so

1 designed and mounted as to be plainly visible and understandable from a distance
2 of 500 feet both during normal sunlight and during hours of darkness. No operator
3 of an authorized emergency vehicle may use the warning lights except when
4 responding to an emergency call or when in pursuit of an actual or suspected violator
5 of the law, when responding to but not upon returning from a fire alarm, when
6 transporting an organ for human transplantation, when transporting medical
7 personnel for the purpose of performing human organ harvesting or transplantation
8 immediately after the transportation, or when necessarily parked in a position which
9 is likely to be hazardous to traffic.”.
