**ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 39**

November 6, 2001 - Offered by Representatives FREESE and TRAVIS.

1     **AN ACT relating to:** requiring the elections board to make recommendations  
2           regarding statewide voter registration and maintenance of a statewide voter  
3           registration list.

*The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:*

4           **SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.**

5           (1) Notwithstanding section 16.42 (1) of the statutes, the elections board shall  
6           submit as a part of its budget request for the 2003-05 fiscal biennium under section  
7           16.42 of the statutes a proposal to create a statewide, centralized voter registration  
8           and poll list system. The proposed system shall be computerized, shall require voter  
9           registration in every municipality in this state, shall be maintained by the elections  
10          board, and shall allow for the real-time entering and checking of voter registration  
11          and polling information by election officials, so as to facilitate the elimination of

1 multiple voting by the same elector at the same election. The proposed system shall  
2 be designed to be operational as of the 2004 spring election.
