ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 496

October 29, 2001 – Offered by Representative MUSSER.

1	AN ACT to renumber 45.19; to amend 20.485 (2) (q), 36.27 (3) (title) and 38.24
2	(5) (title); and <i>to create</i> 36.27 (3r), 38.24 (6), 45.19 (2), 45.19 (3) and 115.28 (51)
3	of the statutes; relating to: tuition vouchers for students who sound Taps at
4	military honors funerals.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
5	SECTION 1. 20.485 (2) (q) of the statutes is amended to read:
6	20.485 (2) (q) Military honors funerals. Biennially, the amounts in the schedule
7	to provide military honors funerals for veterans under s. 45.19 (1) .
8	SECTION 2. 36.27 (3) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:
9	36.27 (3) (title) Tuition remissions <u>for survivors</u> .
LO	SECTION 3. 36.27 (3r) of the statutes is created to read:
11	36.27 (3r) Fee remissions for funeral assistants. The board shall grant a $$25$
12	remission of nonresident tuition or academic fees to any student enrolled in the

system as an undergraduate for each valid voucher issued to the student under s.
 45.19 (3).

3	SECTION 4. 38.24 (5) (title) of the statutes is amended to read:
4	38.24 (5) (title) Fee remissions <u>for survivors</u> .
5	SECTION 5. 38.24 (6) of the statutes is created to read:
6	38.24 (6) FEE REMISSIONS FOR FUNERAL ASSISTANTS. The district board shall grant
7	a $$25$ remission of fees under subs. $(1m)$ and (3) to a student for each valid voucher
8	issued to the student under s. 45.19 (3).
9	SECTION 6. 45.19 of the statutes is renumbered $45.19(1)$.
10	SECTION 7. 45.19 (2) of the statutes is created to read:
11	45.19(2) The department of veterans affairs shall create a tuition voucher form
12	to be used by funeral directors under sub. (3). The department of veterans affairs
13	shall distribute copies of the tuition voucher form, plus an explanation of the form's
14	use, to every operator of a funeral establishment. The department of veterans affairs
15	may not charge a fee for the tuition voucher form or for the distribution of the form.
16	SECTION 8. 45.19 (3) of the statutes is created to read:
17	45.19 (3) A funeral director may issue a tuition voucher in the amount of \$25
18	to an individual who sounds "Taps" on a bugle, trumpet, or cornet during a military
19	honors funeral held in this state for a deceased veteran and who is a student in grades
20	$6\ to\ 12\ or\ at\ an\ institution\ of\ higher\ education,\ as\ defined\ under\ s.\ 895.515\ (1)\ (b).$
21	The tuition voucher may be used at any time for the payment of tuition and required
22	program activity fees at a University of Wisconsin System institution as provided
23	under s. 36.27 (3r) or a technical college as provided under s. 38.24 (6). The
24	department of veterans affairs shall encourage private institutions of higher
25	education to accept the vouchers. The vouchers are not transferable.

1 SECTION 9. 115.28 (51) of the statutes is created to r	ead:

115.28 (51) FUNERAL ASSISTANTS. Encourage school boards to grant an excused
absence to a pupil in grades 6 to 12 for the purpose of sounding "Taps" during a
military honors funeral for a decreased veteran.
