ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1, TO 2001 ASSEMBLY BILL 661

January 8, 2002 – Offered by Representatives PETTIS, BIES and FRISKE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ **1.** Page 2, line 1: delete lines 1 to 4 and substitute: 3 "SECTION 1g. 961.573 (3) of the statutes is amended to read: 4 961.573 (3) No person may use, or possess with the primary intent to use, drug $\mathbf{5}$ paraphernalia to manufacture, compound, convert, produce, process, prepare, test, 6 analyze, pack, repack, or store methamphetamine or a controlled substance analog 7 of methamphetamine in violation of this chapter. Any Subject to sub. (4), any person 8 who violates this subsection may be fined not more than \$10,000 or imprisoned for 9 not more than 5 years or both. 10 **SECTION 1r.** 961.573 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

961.573 (4) Any person who is 18 years of age or older and violates sub. (3) while
in the presence or company of a child who is 16 years of age or younger may be fined
not more than \$20,000 or imprisoned for not more than 10 years or both.".
