**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,
TO SENATE AMENDMENT 3,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 104**

January 29, 2002 – Offered by Senator GEORGE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1, line 3: after that line insert:

3 “2m. Page 3, line 9: delete the material beginning with “under” and ending with
4 “(3)” on line 10 and substitute “or disbursement under s. 11.065 (3) or 11.12 (6) (c)
5 4.”.”.

6 **2.** Page 1, line 6: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
7 page 3, line 8, and substitute:

8 ““11.12 (6) (c) 1. If any committee identified under s. 11.05 (3) (c) as a special
9 interest committee makes one or more communications to be financed with a
10 disbursement for the purpose of advocating the election or defeat of a clearly
11 identified candidate for a state office specified in s. 11.31 (1) (a) to (de), (e), or (f) at

1 the spring or general or a special election, or any such candidate who seeks a
2 nomination for such an office at a primary election, without cooperation or
3 consultation with a candidate or agent or authorized committee of a candidate who
4 is supported or whose opponent is opposed, and not in concert with or at the request
5 or suggestion of such a candidate, agent, or committee, the committee shall file a
6 report with the board. The report shall be made whenever the person makes one or
7 more communications financed or to be financed with disbursements exceeding
8 \$2,000 in the aggregate and whenever the committee makes one or more additional
9 communications financed or to be financed with disbursements exceeding \$2,000 in
10 the aggregate that are not identified in a previous report under this subdivision.
11 Reports required under this subdivision shall be filed within 7 days after the date
12 that communications financed with disbursements exceeding \$2,000 in the
13 aggregate that are not identified in a previous report are made, or if communications
14 are made within 15 days of the date of a spring primary or election or within 15 days
15 of a September or special primary or general or special election, within 24 hours after
16 the date that communications financed with disbursements exceeding \$2,000 in the
17 aggregate that are not identified in a previous report are made.

18 2. If a committee makes or incurs an obligation to make a single disbursement
19 for the purpose of financing communications described under subd. 1. that are to be
20 made on more than one day, the committee may report the entire disbursement
21 under subd. 1. for the day on which the committee makes the first communication
22 financed by the disbursement, or the committee may report for each day on which
23 the committee makes one or more communications financed by the disbursement the
24 proportionate amount of the disbursement attributable to the cost of the
25 communication or communications made on that day.
