## SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2001 SENATE BILL 120

May 30, 2001 – Offered by COMMITTEE ONEDUCATION.

1	AN ACT to create 121.91 (4) (i) of the statutes; relating to: increasing a school
2	district's revenue limit by the amount spent for school safety and security
3	measures and granting rule–making authority.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
4	SECTION 1. 121.91 (4) (i) of the statutes is created to read:
5	121.91 (4) (i) The limit otherwise applicable to a school district's revenue under
6	sub. (2m) in any school year is increased by an amount equal to the amount spent by
7	the school district in that school year for safety measures designed to protect pupils
8	and staff and for security measures designed to prevent criminal activity in schools,
9	as determined by the state superintendent, but not more than an amount equal to
LO	\$100 multiplied by the number of pupils enrolled. The state superintendent shall
11	promulgate rules specifying the safety and security measures that are eligible for a
12	revenue limit adjustment under this paragraph.

## 1 SECTION 2. Initial applicability.

- 2 (1) This act first applies to the calculation of a school district's revenue limit
- 3 for the school year beginning after the effective date of this subsection.
