| 5 | (a) "Council" means the deaf and hard-of-hearing education council. |
| 6 | (b) "Hearing impaired" has the meaning given in s. 115.51 (2). |
| 7 | (2) The state superintendent shall seek the advice of and consult with the |
| 8 | council on issues related to persons who are hearing impaired. The state |
| 9 | superintendent and the director of the Wisconsin Educational Services Program for |
| 10 | the Deaf and Hard of Hearing, or their designees, shall attend meetings of the |
| 11 | council. |
| 12 | (3) The council shall do all of the following: |
| 13 | (a) Meet at least twice each year. |

| 14 | (5) The council shall have access to public files, public records, and statistics |
| 15 | kept in the department that relate to matters concerning children who are hearing |
| 16 | impaired.". |
