**SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 255**

February 20, 2002 - Offered by Senator GROBSCHMIDT.

1 **AN ACT** *to repeal* 121.004 (7) (cm); and *to amend* 121.004 (7) (c) 1. a. and b.,
2 121.004 (7) (c) 2., 121.004 (7) (f) and 121.86 (3) of the statutes; **relating to:** the
3 manner in which a pupil enrolled in a kindergarten program is counted for state
4 aid.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 121.004 (7) (c) 1. a. and b. of the statutes are amended to read:
6 121.004 (7) (c) 1. a. A pupil enrolled in a ~~5-year-old~~ kindergarten program
7 requiring full-day attendance for 5 days a week for an entire school year shall be
8 counted as one pupil.
9 b. A pupil enrolled in a ~~5-year-old~~ kindergarten program requiring full-day
10 attendance for less fewer than 5 days a week for an ~~entire~~ all or part of a school year
11 shall be counted as the result obtained by ~~multiplying the number of hours in each~~
12 ~~day in which the pupil is enrolled by the total number of days for which the pupil is~~

1 enrolled, and dividing the result total number of hours that the pupil is enrolled by
2 the product of the number of hours of attendance per day required of first grade
3 pupils in the school district multiplied by 180.

4 **SECTION 2.** 121.004 (7) (c) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

5 121.004 (7) (c) 2. In subd. 1. a. and b., “full-day” means the length of the school
6 day for pupils in the first grade of the school district operating the ~~5-year-old~~
7 kindergarten program.

8 **SECTION 3.** 121.004 (7) (cm) of the statutes is repealed.

9 **SECTION 4.** 121.004 (7) (f) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 121.004 (7) (f) A pupil who transfers from one school district to another under
11 s. 121.85 (3) (a) shall be counted by the school district in which the pupil resides as
12 0.75 pupil or, if appropriate, as a number equal to the result obtained by multiplying
13 0.75 by the appropriate fraction under par. (c), ~~(cm)~~ or (d).

14 **SECTION 5.** 121.86 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

15 121.86 (3) STATE AID EXCEPTION. Pupils under sub. (2) (b) and (c) who are
16 enrolled in a kindergarten program or in a preschool program under subch. V of ch.
17 115 shall be multiplied under sub. (2) (a) 2. by a number equal to the result obtained
18 by multiplying 0.25 by the appropriate fraction under s. 121.004 (7) (c), ~~(cm)~~ or (d).

19 **SECTION 6. Initial applicability.**

20 (1) This act first applies to the distribution of state school aid in the 2002-03
21 school year.
