ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2001 SENATE BILL 336

February 26, 2002 – Offered by Representative FREESE.

1	AN ACT to amend 23.33 (5) (c) and 30.68 (3) (b); to repeal and recreate 23.33
2	(5) (b); and <i>to create</i> 30.68 (3) (bm) of the statutes; relating to: safety training
3	for all-terrain vehicle and motorboat operation.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
4	SECTION 1. 23.33 (5) (b) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:
5	23.33 (5) (b) All-terrain vehicle safety certificate. 1. No person who is at least
6	12 years of age and who is born on or after January 1, 1987, may operate an
7	all-terrain vehicle unless he or she holds a valid safety certificate.
8	2. Any person who is required to hold an all-terrain vehicle safety certificate
9	while operating an all-terrain vehicle shall carry the certificate on the all-terrain
10	vehicle and shall display the certificate to a law enforcement officer on request.
11	Persons enrolled in a safety certification program approved by the department may
12	operate an all-terrain vehicle in an area designated by the instructor.

2001 – 2002 Legislature

1	SECTION 2. 23.33 (5) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:
2	23.33 (5) (c) <i>Exceptions</i> . Paragraphs (a) and (b) do not apply to a person who
3	operates an all-terrain vehicle exclusively on land under the management and
4	control of the person's immediate family. Paragraphs (a) and (b) do not apply to a
5	person at least 12 years of age but under 16 years of age who holds a valid certificate
6	issued by another state or a province of Canada.
7	SECTION 3. 30.68 (3) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	30.68 (3) (b) No person under the age of 10 years may operate a motorboat.
9	Persons at least 10 and less than 12 years of age may operate a motorboat only if they
10	are either accompanied in the boat by a parent or guardian or a person at least 18
11	years of age designated by a parent or guardian. Persons at least 12 and less than
12	16 years of age may operate a motor of any horsepower, but only if they are either
13	accompanied by a parent or guardian or a person at least 18 years of age designated
14	by a parent or guardian, or in possession of a certificate issued under s. 30.74 (1).
15	This paragraph does not apply to personal watercraft.
16	SECTION 4. 30.68 (3) (bm) of the statutes is created to read:
17	30.68 (3) (bm) 1. In this paragraph, "motorboat safety certificate" means a
18	certificate issued under s. 30.74 (1).
19	2. No person who is at least 12 years of age but less than 18 years of age may
20	operate a motorboat without holding a valid motorboat safety certificate.
21	2m. No person who is at least 18 years of age and who is born on or after
22	January 1, 1985, may operate a motorboat without holding a valid motorboat safety
23	certificate unless the motorboat is driven by a motor of 50 horsepower or less.
24	3. Any person who is required to hold a motorboat safety certificate while
25	operating a motorboat shall carry the certificate on the motorboat and shall display

the certificate to a law enforcement officer on request. Persons enrolled in a safety
certification program approved by the department may operate a motorboat in an
area designated by the instructor.
4. This paragraph does not apply to personal watercraft. **SECTION 5. Effective date.**(1) This act takes effect on January 1, 2003.
