**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 100,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55**

June 29, 2001 – Offered by Representative SCHNEIDER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 514, line 6: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 1349s.** 36.11 (8) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 36.11 (8) (b) ~~The board~~ Except as provided in par. (bm), the board shall
5 establish fines for the violation of any rule made under par. (a). The institutions are
6 authorized to collect such fines together with moneys collected from the sale of
7 parking permits and other fees established under par. (a) and such moneys shall be
8 paid into the state treasury and credited to s. 20.285 (1) (h), to be used only for the
9 purpose of developing and operating parking or other transportation facilities at the
10 institution at which collected and for enforcing parking rules under par. (a).

11 **SECTION 1349t.** 36.11 (8) (bm) of the statutes is created to read:

1 36.11 (8) (bm) No fine may be charged for a parking violation, other than a
2 violation relating to parking for motor vehicles used by the physically disabled,
3 occurring during the period beginning on the first day on which final examinations
4 are administered in a semester and ending on the seventh day after the last final
5 examination is administered in that semester.”.

6 **2.** Page 520, line 17: after that line insert:

7 “**SECTION 1371b.** 38.14 (13) of the statutes is amended to read:

8 38.14 (13) PARKING REGULATIONS AND FEES. The district board may adopt
9 resolutions regulating the parking of motor vehicles on property under its
10 jurisdiction. The resolutions may establish a fee for the parking of motor vehicles
11 by students, faculty, staff, and visitors and fines for the violation of any parking
12 regulation. No fine may be charged for a parking violation, other than a violation
13 relating to parking for motor vehicles used by the physically disabled, occurring
14 during the period beginning on the first day on which final examinations are
15 administered in a semester and ending on the seventh day after the last final
16 examination is administered in that semester. Nothing in this subsection requires
17 that all users of the parking facilities be charged a parking fee.”.

18 **3.** Page 1408, line 21: after that line insert:

19 “(2q) PARKING. The treatment of section 38.14 (13) of the statutes first applies
20 to parking violations occurring on the effective date of this subsection.”.

21 **4.** Page 1411, line 17: after that line insert:

22 “(1q) PARKING. The treatment of section 36.11 (8) (b) and (bm) of the statutes
23 first applies to parking violations occurring on the effective date of this subsection.”.
