ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 119, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55

June 29, 2001 – Offered by Representatives Schooff, Miller and Lassa.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 116, line 21: delete lines 21 and 22.
3	2. Page 296, line 24: after that line insert:
4	"SECTION 438m. 20.143 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:
5	20.143 (1) (c) Wisconsin development fund; grants, loans, reimbursements and
6	assistance. Biennially, the amounts in the schedule for grants under ss. 560.145,
7	<u>560.155,</u> 560.16, 560.175 and 560.26; for grants and loans under ss. 560.62, 560.63
8	and 560.66; for loans under s. 560.147; for reimbursements under s. 560.167; for
9	providing assistance under s. 560.06; for the costs specified in s. 560.607; for the loan
10	under 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, section 9110 (4); and for the grants under 1995
11	Wisconsin Act 27, section 9116 (7gg), 1995 Wisconsin Act 119, section 2 (1), 1997
12	Wisconsin Act 27, section 9110 (6g), and 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, section 9110 (5). Of

1	the amounts in the schedule, \$50,000 shall be allocated in each of fiscal years
2	1997-98 and 1998-99 for providing the assistance under s. 560.06 (1).
3	Notwithstanding s. 560.607, of the amounts in the schedule, \$125,000 shall be
4	allocated in each of 4 consecutive fiscal years, beginning with fiscal year 1998–99,
5	for grants and loans under s. 560.62 (1) (a).".
6	3. Page 300, line 16: delete lines 16 to 21.
7	4. Page 396, line 20: delete lines 20 to 22.
8	5. Page 1162, line 8: delete lines 8 to 10 and substitute:
9	"SECTION 3649. 560.155 (1) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
10	560.155 (1) (intro.) Subject to sub. (2), from the appropriation under s. 20.143
11	(1) (c), the department may award a grant to a business if all of the following apply:".
