ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 36, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55

June 29, 2001 – Offered by Representative WASSERMAN.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 134, line 8: decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2001–02 by
3	2,000,000 and decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year $2002-03$ by $2,500,000$ to
4	reflect elimination of the high school graduation test.
5	2. Page 918, line 19: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 2698g. 118.153 (1) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
7	118.153 (1) (a) (intro.) "Children at risk" means pupils in grades 5 to 12 who
8	are at risk of not graduating from high school because they failed the high school
9	graduation examination administered under s. 118.30 (1m) (d), are dropouts, or are
10	2 or more of the following:
11	SECTION 2698j. 118.153 (4) (c) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

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1	118.153 (4) (c) 3. The pupil, if a high school senior, received a high school
2	diploma or passed the high school graduation examination administered under s.
3	118.30 (1m) (d).
4	SECTION 2698m. 118.30 (1g) (b) of the statutes is repealed.".
5	3. Page 919, line 20: after that line insert:
6	"SECTION 2703m. 118.30 (1m) (d) of the statutes is repealed.".
7	4. Page 920, line 19: after that line insert:
8	"SECTION 2707m. 118.30 (1r) (d) of the statutes is repealed.
9	SECTION 2707p. 118.30 (2) (e) of the statutes is repealed.".
10	5. Page 920, line 19: after that line insert:
11	"Section 2718m. 118.33 (1) (f) 1. and 2. of the statutes are amended to read:
12	118.33 (1) (f) 1. By September 1, 2002, each school board operating high school
13	grades shall develop a written policy specifying criteria for granting a high school
14	diploma that are in addition to the requirements under par. (a). The criteria shall
15	include the pupil's score on the examination administered under s. 118.30 (1m) (d),
16	the pupil's academic performance and the recommendations of teachers. Except as
17	provided in subd. 2., the criteria apply to pupils enrolled in charter schools located
18	in the school district.
19	2. By September 1, 2002, each operator of a charter school under s. 118.40 $(2r)$
20	that operates high school grades shall develop a policy specifying criteria for
21	granting a high school diploma. The criteria shall include the pupil's score on the
22	examination administered under s. 118.30 (1r) (d), the pupil's academic performance
23	and the recommendations of teachers.".
