**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 7,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 2001 SENATE BILL 55**

June 29, 2001 – Offered by Representatives BLACK, MILLER, LASSA and BERCEAU.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 309, line 12: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 481d.** 20.235 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 20.235 (1) (b) *Tuition grants.* ~~Biennially, the amounts in the schedule A sum~~
5 sufficient equal to the amount determined under s. 39.30 (5) for the purposes of s.
6 39.30.”.

7 **2.** Page 309, line 20: after that line insert:

8 “**SECTION 481p.** 20.235 (1) (fe) of the statutes is amended to read:

9 20.235 (1) (fe) *Wisconsin higher education grants; University of Wisconsin*
10 *System students.* ~~Biennially, the amounts in the schedule A sum sufficient equal to~~

1 program under s. 39.435 for University of Wisconsin System students, except for
2 grants awarded under s. 39.435 (2) or (5).

3 **SECTION 481q.** 20.235 (1) (fg) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 20.235 (1) (fg) *Minority undergraduate retention grants program.* ~~Biennially,~~
5 ~~the amounts in the schedule A~~ sum sufficient equal to the amount determined under
6 s. 39.44 (2m) for the minority undergraduate retention grant program under s.
7 39.44.”.

8 **3.** Page 324, line 23: after that line insert:

9 “**SECTION 582p.** 20.285 (4) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

10 20.285 (4) (b) *Graduate student financial aid.* ~~The amounts in the schedule A~~
11 sum sufficient equal to the amount determined under s. 36.25 (14) (a) for grants to
12 minority and disadvantaged graduate students under s. 36.25 (14).

13 **SECTION 582s.** 20.285 (4) (dd) of the statutes is amended to read:

14 20.285 (4) (dd) *Lawton minority undergraduate grants program.* ~~The amounts~~
15 ~~in the schedule A~~ sum sufficient equal to the amount determined under s. 36.34 (1)
16 (c) for the Lawton minority undergraduate grant program under s. 36.34 (1).”.

17 **4.** Page 517, line 8: after that line insert:

19 **SECTION 1355n.** 36.25 (14) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

20 fiscal year after fiscal year 2003-04, “base amount” means the appropriation
21 determined under par. (b) for the previous fiscal year.

16 appropriation amount determined under par. (b) for the previous fiscal year.

17 (b) Annually, by February 1, the board shall determine the appropriation under
18 s. 20.235 (1) (fg) for the next fiscal year as follows:

19 1. The board shall determine the percentage by which the undergraduate
20 academic fees charged for the current academic year at each institution within the

6 and (fg) of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 2003.”.

7 **9.** Page 1426, line 24: after that line insert:

8 “(2f) GRANT AND TUITION INCREASES. The treatment of sections 20.285 (4) (b) and
9 (dd) of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 2003.”.
