ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 359

February 11, 2004 – Offered by Representative WIECKERT.

1	AN ACT to amend 16.47 (1); and to create 16.47 (1e) of the statutes; relating
2	to: requirements for the executive budget bill or bills.
	The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
3	SECTION 1. 16.47 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 2003 Wisconsin Act 33, is
4	amended to read:
5	16.47 (1) Except as provided in s. 16.529 (2), the executive budget bill or bills
6	shall incorporate the governor's recommendations for appropriations for the
7	succeeding <u>fiscal</u> biennium <u>and shall satisfy the condition under sub. (1e)</u> . The
8	appropriation method shown in the bill or bills shall in no way affect the amount of
9	detail or manner of presentation which may be requested by the joint committee on
10	finance. Appropriation requests may be divided into 3 allotments: personal services,
11	other operating expenses and capital outlay or such other meaningful classifications
12	as may be approved by the joint committee on finance.

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SECTION 2. 16.47 (1e) of the statutes is created to read: 1 $\mathbf{2}$ 16.47 (1e) The executive budget bill or bills may not authorize expenditures 3 in any year of the succeeding fiscal biennium that would cause, in any of those fiscal years, the amount of moneys designated as "Total Expenditures" in the summary 4 $\mathbf{5}$ under s. 20.005 (1) for that fiscal year, as published in the executive budget bill or 6 bills, less any amounts transferred to the budget stabilization fund in that fiscal year, $\mathbf{7}$ to exceed the sum of the amount of moneys designated as "Taxes" and "Departmental 8 Revenues" in the summary under s. 20.005 (1) for that fiscal year, as published in the 9 executive budget bill or bills.
