## ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2003 ASSEMBLY BILL 68

March 13, 2003 - Offered by Representatives Pettis, Ladwig, Krawczyk, Stone, Van Roy, Hines and Seratti.

1 AN ACT *to create* 118.33 (1) (e) of the statutes; **relating to:** granting high school credit for extracurricular sports.

## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law requires a high school pupil to earn 1.5 credits in physical education in order to be eligible for a high school diploma. This bill authorizes a school board to grant a pupil credit in physical education for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is coached by a person who is licensed to teach physical education.

## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**Section 1.** 118.33 (1) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

118.33 (1) (e) A school board may grant a pupil credit in physical education under par. (a) 1. for participating in an extracurricular sport if the sport is coached by a person who is licensed to teach physical education.

## **SECTION 2. Initial applicability.**

- 1 (1) This act first applies to high school diplomas granted on the effective date of this subsection.
- 3 (END)
