## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 20, TO 2003 SENATE BILL 44

June 19, 2003 – Offered by Representative MILLER.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the bill, as shown by senate substitute
<b>2</b>	amendment 1, as follows:
3	1. Page 211, line 15: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2003–04 by
4	\$750,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2004–05 by \$750,000 to
5	increase funding for literacy grants.
6	<b>2.</b> Page 510, line 4: delete lines 4 to 11 and substitute:
7	"49.169 (2) The department shall award not more than \$1,404,100 \$750,000
8	<u>per fiscal year</u> in grants to qualified applicants for the provision of literacy training
9	to individuals who are eligible for temporary assistance for needy families under 42
10	USC 601 et. <u>et</u> seq.".
11	<b>3.</b> Page 513, line 10: delete that line and substitute:
12	<b>"SECTION 1270c.</b> 49.175 (1) (y) of the statutes is amended to read:

1	49.175 (1) (y) <i>Literacy initiative grants</i> . For literacy grants under s. 49.169 and
2	literacy services administered by the governor's office, \$1,425,800, <u>\$750,000</u> in fiscal
3	year <del>2001–02</del> <u>2003–04</u> and <del>\$800,000</del> <u>\$750,000</u> in fiscal year <del>2002–03</del> <u>2004–05</u> .".
