10	(b) An individual who is eligible for a transitional subsidized private sector job
11	under the program satisfies eligibility criteria specified by the department.
12	(c) An employer that provides a transitional subsidized private sector job

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- (d) An individual employed in a transitional subsidized private sector job performs useful work for his or her employer, is paid by the employer, and may be eligible for income tax credits and refunds.
- (e) The department specifies any time limitations that apply to participation in a transitional subsidized private sector job.
- (f) An individual employed in a transitional subsidized private sector job may be required to search for unsubsidized employment during his or her participation.
- (g) The department may provide for education or training activities in which an individual employed in a transitional subsidized private sector job may participate.
- (h) The department may include any other features that the department determines will promote successful participation in unsubsidized employment by individuals employed in transitional subsidized private sector jobs.
- (2) EVALUATION AND REPORT. On or before December 31, 2008, the department shall evaluate, and submit a report on, the program created under sub. (1) to the legislature under s. 13.172 (2) and to the governor. The report shall include an evaluation of the program's effectiveness in enabling individuals employed under the program to obtain and successfully participate in jobs in the private labor market.".
