SENATE AMENDMENT 58, TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2003 SENATE BILL 44

June 18, 2003 – Offered by Senator CARPENTER.

- 1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
- 2

1. Page 1079, line 21: after that line insert:

3 "(5c) EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ON CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM, STATE BUDGET 4 REFORM, AND STATE GOVERNMENT ETHICS REFORM. The passage of this bill by both houses $\mathbf{5}$ shall constitute the call of the legislature into extraordinary session. The business 6 of the extraordinary session is limited to the adoption of campaign finance reform, 7 state budget reform, and state government ethics reform. Notwithstanding section 8 1 (4) (a) of 2003 Senate Joint Resolution 1, the legislature may not finally adjourn 9 the extraordinary session until enrolled bills that, collectively, accomplish campaign 10 finance reform, state budget reform, and state government ethics reform have been passed by both houses. Notwithstanding section 1 (4) (c) of 2003 Senate Joint 11 Resolution 1, the extraordinary session shall immediately reconvene solely for the 12

- 1 consideration of executive vetoes or partial vetoes if an enrolled bill passed by both
- 2 houses during the extraordinary session is vetoed or partially vetoed.".
