SENATE AMENDMENT 98, TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, TO 2003 SENATE BILL 44

June 18, 2003 – Offered by Senator JAUCH.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 436, line 11: delete that line and substitute:
3	"38.17 Levy limit. (1) DEFINITION. In this section:".
4	2. Page 436, line 12: delete that line and substitute:
5	"(a) "Debt service" includes debt service on debt issued or reissued to fund or
6	refund outstanding municipal".
7	3. Page 436, line 14: after that line insert:
8	"(b) "State mandate" means a state law that requires a district board to engage
9	in an activity or provide a service, or to increase the level of its activities or services.
10	(c) "Unfunded state mandate" means a state mandate for which the state does
11	not provide a district board with the entire amount of the district's costs of complying
12	with the state mandate.".

1	4. Page 437, line 8: after that line insert:
2	"(c) The limit otherwise applicable under sub. (2) for the current fiscal year is
3	increased by an amount equal to the cost incurred by a district board to comply with
4	an unfunded state mandate.".
5	5. Page 595, line 15: after that line insert:
6	"(be) "State mandate" means a state law that requires a political subdivision
7	to engage in an activity or provide a service, or to increase the level of its activities
8	or services.
9	(bs) "Unfunded state mandate" means a state mandate for which the state does
10	not provide a political subdivision with the entire amount of the political
11	subdivision's costs of complying with the state mandate.".
12	6. Page 596, line 22: after that line insert:
13	"(e) The levy increase limit otherwise applicable under this section to the
14	political subdivision in the current year is increased by an amount equal to the cost
15	incurred by a political subdivision to comply with an unfunded state mandate.".
