3. Page 210, line 18: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2005–06 by
\$28,700 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2006-07 by \$28,700 to

to operate a minority youth substance abuse treatment program.

- **4.** Page 210, line 18: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2005-06 by \$17,900 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2006-07 by \$17,900 to increase funding for court-appointed special advocate programs.
 - **5.** Page 311, line 9: delete that line and substitute:

"Section 415p. 20.505 (6) (j) 3. of the statutes is renumbered 20.455 (2) (i) 3. and amended to read:

"Section 415z. 20.505 (6) (kp) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.505 **(6)** (kp) Anti-drug enforcement program, penalty surcharge — local. The amounts in the schedule to match federal funds made available under subtitle K of title I of P.L. 99–570. All moneys transferred from the appropriation account under par. (j) s. 20.455 (2) (i) 3. shall be credited to this appropriation account.".

7. Page 848, line 3: delete lines 3 to 7 and substitute:

"Section 2226t. 302.05 (1) of the statutes is renumbered 302.05 (1) (a), and 302.05 (1) (a) (intro.), as renumbered, is amended to read:

302.05 (1) (a) (intro.) The department of corrections and the department of health and family services may designate a section of a mental health institute as a correctional treatment facility for the treatment of substance abuse of inmates

$transferred \ from \ Wisconsin \ state \ prisons. \ This \ section \ shall \ be \ administered \ by \ the$		
department of corrections and shall be known as the Wisconsin substance abuse		
program. The department of corrections and the department of health and family
