



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 44,  
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 100**

June 21, 2005 – Offered by Representatives SHERIDAN and SCHNEIDER.

1           At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2           **1.** Page 575, line 17: delete that line and substitute: “poultry, including  
3 farm-raised pheasants, but not including other farm-raised game birds or ratites;  
4 fish that are raised in”.

5           **2.** Page 648, line 2: delete that line and substitute: “poultry, including  
6 farm-raised pheasants, but not including other farm-raised game birds or ratites;  
7 fish that are raised in”.

8           **3.** Page 684, line 5: delete that line and substitute: “poultry, including  
9 farm-raised pheasants, but not including other farm-raised game birds or ratites;  
10 fish that are raised in”.

11           **4.** Page 986, line 6: after that line insert:

1           “(7p) MANAGED FOREST LAND YIELD TAX EXEMPTION. Notwithstanding the  
2 requirement to pay a yield tax specified under section 77.87 (1) of the statutes, an  
3 owner of managed forest land is exempt from the payment of the yield tax under  
4 section 77.87 (1) of the statutes on any timber that was damaged by the forest fire  
5 that occurred on May 5, 2005, in Adams County and that is harvested before May 1,  
6 2006.”.
