# SENATE AMENDMENT 18, TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 100 

June 29, 2005 - Offered by Senators Wirch, Carpenter, Cogqs, Plale, Breske, Robson, Lassa and Miller.

At the locations indicated, amend the engrossed bill as follows:

1. Page 34 , line 1 : delete that line and substitute:
"Section 89d. 16.964 (9) (intro.) of the statutes is amended to read:
16.964 (9) (intro.) From the appropriations under s. 20.505 (6) (kp) and (p), the office of justice assistance shall provide $\$ 185,000 \$ 100,000$ annually to the department of health and family services to distribute the following grants for children's community programs:

Section 89e. 16.964 (9) (a) of the statutes is repealed.
Section 89f. 16.964 (9) (b) of the statutes is repealed.".
2. Page 210 , line 10 : after that line insert:
"(kp) Anti-drug enforcement program, penalty surcharge local

PR-S A 25,000

25,000 ".
3. Page 210, line 18: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2005-06 by $\$ 35,800$ and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year $2006-07$ by $\$ 35,800$ to increase funding for court-appointed special advocate programs.
4. Page 311, line 15: delete that line and substitute:
"Section 415p. 20.505 (6) (j) 3. of the statutes is renumbered 20.455 (2) (i) 3. and amended to read:
20.455 (2) (i) 3. The amount transferred to par. s. 20.505 (6) (kp) shall be the amount in the schedule under par. s. 20.505 (6) (kp).".
5. Page 313, line 6: delete that line and substitute:
"Section 415z. 20.505 (6) (kp) of the statutes is amended to read:
20.505 (6) (kp) Anti-drug enforcement program, penalty surcharge - local. The amounts in the schedule to match federal funds made available under subtitle K of title I of P.L. 99-570. All moneys transferred from the appropriation account under par. (j) s. 20.455 (2) (i) 3 . shall be credited to this appropriation account.".
