ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2, TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1, **TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 15**

March 3, 2005 – Offered by Committee on Agriculture.

1	At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:
2	1. Page 2, line 1: delete that line and substitute:
3	"SECTION 1m. 168.04 (2m) and (2r) of the statutes are created to read:".
4	2. Page 2, line 8: after that line insert:
5	"(2r) (a) In this subsection, "regular supplier" means a supplier who supplies
6	a retailer of automotive gasoline with 50 percent or more of the retailer's automotive
7	gasoline for sale at retail.
8	(b) If a retailer of automotive gasoline is unable to obtain a sufficient supply
9	of automotive gasoline that satisfies the ethanol requirements described in sub. (2m)
10	(b) from the retailer's regular supplier to meet the retailer's demand for automotive
11	gasoline, the retailer may apply to the secretary of administration for a waiver of the
12	ethanol requirements described under sub. (2m) (b). If the secretary of

administration determines, after consultation with the secretary of commerce and 1 $\mathbf{2}$ the secretary of agriculture, trade and consumer protection that the retailer's regular supplier cannot meet the retailer's demand for automotive gasoline that 3 satisfies the ethanol requirements described under sub. (2m) (b), the secretary of 4 $\mathbf{5}$ administration shall waive those requirements for gasoline sold by that retailer and, 6 without further application, for any other retailer for whom the supplier is the $\mathbf{7}$ retailer's regular supplier. The waiver shall be for a period of time not to exceed 7 8 days.".
