



**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 4,
TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 3,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 15**

December 15, 2005 – Offered by Representatives BERCEAU and FRISKE.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 4, line 4: after that line insert:

3 **“SECTION 4m. Nonstatutory provisions.**

4 (1) COMMITTEE. (a) In this subsection, “cellulosic biomass ethanol” means
5 ethanol derived from any lignocellulosic matter that is available on a renewable or
6 recurring basis including dedicated energy crops and trees, wood and wood residues,
7 plants, grasses, agricultural residues, fibers, animal waste and other waste
8 materials, and municipal solid waste. “Cellulosic biomass ethanol” includes any
9 ethanol produced in facilities where animal wastes or other waste materials are
10 digested or otherwise used to displace 90 percent or more of the fossil fuel normally
11 used in the production of ethanol.
